## M.C.B.A. Inc. Code of Ethics

## This constitutes the guidelines of conduct for all members of the Mutation Chinchilla Breeders Association, Inc. as established by its by-laws and the Board of Directors.

- 1. Live up to and abide with the By-Laws of the organization.
- 2. Make no false claims or bring discredit upon the MCBA in writing, or in any other manner.
- 3. Fulfill all obligations promptly.
- 4. Do not use membership in the MCBA as a basis for advantages in sales, promotions, statements, or claims in the selling of animals or products.
- 5. Make all representations and agreements in writing.
- 6. Recognize every person's inherit right to be treated fairly. Be honest in all transactions and representations. Do not distort or exaggerate to complete a transaction.
- 7. Do not become a member of, employee of, volunteer for, investigator for, or be paid by any animal rights organization or support any system, program or policy in conflict with MCBA, Inc.
- 8. Support humane euthanasia and the rights of others to ranch chinchillas for pelt production.
- 9. Always strive to enhance the name of MCBA.

10. For the safety of the animals at a show, no animal entered in a show may have had or been exposed to a communicable disease for a minimum of ninety (90) days prior to the show. If you have any sick animals in your herd, you may not show, unless your herd has been clear of illness for at least 90 days.
